

ARENA SYSTEMS COVID19 POLICY AND PROCEDURES WHEN ENGAGING IN WORK ON CLIENTS SITES

Arena Systems Ltd is considered essential services as per the COVID 19 and MBIE websites

As a consequence, we will be following the guideline outlines on these websites to keep our staff and clients' sites safe from possible contamination of the virus.

Our practice will be:

- 1. All work will the taken through our call lines and emails only.
- Only work that is prearranged will be done. No work will be discussed or engaged with outside of these two communications methods. Only work pre-arranged will be completed at each site visit.
- 3. Your on-site procedures for COVID19 response and procedures must be emailed to us prior to our visit to your site
- 4. All keys and cards for access to the site must also have a prearranged drop off point.
- 5. Our staff will have their own PPE supplied. If specific PPE of a higher level is required for your site this MUST be discussed and provided by courier prior to our staff entering your site.
- 6. All contact with your staff will be managed through phone calls. There is to be no physical contact during our time on your site.
- 7. If you have staff on site, then the 2 metre rule MUST be adhered to at all times.
- 8. Our staff will make contact via phone call to advise that they are finished and advise of any testing that may be required by your staff members.
- 9. All keys and cards will be sprayed with disinfectant and replaced in the prearranged receptacle. We would expect your own staff to also follow the same procedure for disinfecting.
- 10. Our team will be advised that they MUST use hand sanitizer BEFORE and AFTER work is done on your site. And a thorough hand wash to be done at the first opportunity.
- 11. All work will be confirmed as complete through emails and phone calls, keeping physical interaction with your staff to a minimum.
- 12. If any of your staff show symptoms of the COVID19 virus after our visit to your site, we must be contacted immediately.

None of our team have been overseas, and as a result have not been required to isolate or be quarantined as per the Government requirements have stipulated.

All staff have endeavoured to comply with the 2 metre distancing and Level 4 Isolation "bubble" bought into practice on the 26^{th} March.
